## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## **ABOUT THE MORRISON FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

Launched in 2021, the Morrison Family Scholarship Program (MFSP) provides an opportunity for first generation Wingstop Restaurants Inc. team members and brand partner team members to apply for scholarships.

## WHAT TYPES OF DEGREES OR CERTIFICATIONS ARE ELIGIBLE?

Four-year undergraduate degrees, two-year associate degrees, and post-secondary technical or trade certifications from accredited institutions.

# WHAT ARE THE ELIGIBLY REQUIREMENTS?

- Be a current team member who has been employed by the recommending WRI manager or brand partner for a minimum of twelve months continuous employment.
- Be recommended by a brand partner or WRI manager in good standing as defined in the WRI franchise agreement.
- Maintain a minimum 3.0 grade point average in high school and graduate or provide proof of high school graduation or equivalent, such as GED, with a minimum 3.0 grade point average.
- Applicant is a graduating high school student or equivalent, or previously started post-secondary education, stopped, and would like to restart.
- Applicant must be first generation within a family to attend a post-secondary educational institution, meaning applicant has parents or a guardian who did not complete a four-year college degree.
- Be accepted by an accredited educational institution in a post-secondary technical certification, two-year associate degree, or four-year undergraduate degree program.

#### WHERE DO I APPLY?

Applicants may apply online <a href="here">here</a>, applications close April 1, 2022.

#### **HOW MUCH CAN I RECEIVE?**



Scholarships may be maximum annual awards up to \$2,500, multi-year awards may be up to \$5,000 total.

#### WHAT DOES THE AWARD COVER?

Funds may be applied toward the cost of post-secondary education tuition, fees and books.

## WHERE DO YOU SEND THE AWARD FUNDS?

Scholarship award funds will be distributed directly to the accredited post-secondary education institution attended by the awardee. Funds will be distributed via ACH.

## WHO REVIEWS THE APPLICATIONS?

Applications are blindly reviewed by a subcommittee of the Wingstop Charities Board of Directors.

## WHEN WILL SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS BE ANNOUNCED?

Applications will be open through April 1, 2022. Recipients will be notified by May 2022, with funding completed by August 2022.
