



## **MORRISON FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

The Morrison Family Scholarship Program creates opportunities for first generation Wingstop and brand partner team members to apply for scholarships. Team members pursuing a master's degree, four-year undergraduate degrees, two-year associate degrees and post-secondary technical or trade certifications from accredited institutions can receive up to \$5k per year (\$2,500 per semester).

### **WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY:**

- All active Team members, *(excluding the ineligible categories)*
- Full time or Part time Team members employed for a minimum of 6 continuous months.
- Team members recommended by a brand partner of WRI manager in good standing.
- Team members that have graduated from high school and earned a High School diploma or GED or will graduate from high school.
- Team members who previously started postsecondary education, stopped, and would like to restart.
- Team members who are first generation within their family to attend a post-secondary educational institution, meaning applicant parents or a guardian who did not complete a four-year college degree.
- Team members who have been accepted by an accredited educational institution in a post-secondary technical certification, two-year associate degree, four-year undergraduate or master's degree program.

### **WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO REAPPLY:**

- Team members who meet the standard eligibility requirements above.
- Team members who maintained a minimum 3.0 grade point average in their post-secondary program. (Official Transcripts required.)

### **THE FOLLOWING CATEGORIES ARE INELIGIBLE:**

- Children and family members of WRI Vice Presidents and above.
- Children and family members of brand partner Vice Presidents and above.
- Wingstop brand partners and WRI Vice Presidents and above.
- Children of brand partners, unless currently employed by the brand.
- Students who are currently enrolled and attending a postsecondary program.

### **THINGS TO KNOW:**

- Educational grants are available for first generation college students pursuing educational accolades starting at trade certificates
- The program will support students pursuing four-year and two-year degrees, as well as technical or trade certifications from accredited institutions.
- Scholarships of \$2,500 are granted per cycle, multi-year awards may be up to \$5,000 total.
- Funds may be applied toward the cost of post-secondary education tuition, fees, and books.
- Scholarship award funds will be distributed via ACH, directly to the accredited post-secondary education institution attended by the grant recipient.
- Recipients must complete scholarship acceptance form by the deadline. If the acceptance form is not completed by the deadline, the scholarship will be forfeited.
- Applications are blindly reviewed by a subcommittee of the Wingstop Charities Board of Directors.
- If applying to the Spring Cycle, TMs should be planning to attend a program or begin classes in Fall Semester. If applying to the Fall Cycle, TMs should be planning to attend a program or begin classes in the Spring semester.

## **READY TO AMPLIFY THE FLAVOR OF YOUR EDUCATION?**

- 1.) Create a Grant interface account and password then complete the application for the current cycle. [Apply now](#)
- 2.) Ensure that all required fields and supporting documentation are submitted by the cycle deadline.
- 3.) Your application will be reviewed by the subcommittee, and you will be notified 4-6 weeks after the cycle closes.
- 4.) If awarded, completed required scholarship acceptance and next steps by the deadline
